In the recreational vehicle sector, for instance, the pressboard used for interior panelling up to now absorbs water very quickly whereas LAMILUX LAMIGraph is able to withstand regular exposure. This prevents mould from forming and also helps the caravan to retain its value for the long term.

### **Face sheets and décor in one**

LAMILUX LAMIGraph is a typical 2-in-1 material from the plastics specialist. Developer Dr Julia Ewert explains what exactly this means for customers: "GRP face sheeting and décor paper are firmly attached to one another in our flat sheet production. This saves the customer a step in their manufacturing processes and, consequently, labour costs and additional outlay for adhesive.
